





Examples

Ben is in his house. I can't see him.

Look, Ben is in front of his house. I can see him!



Remember!

We use prepositions of place to say where things are.

Examples

Where's the cat? It's hiding behind the chair.

I don't like sitting next to my brother in the car.

Have you got any apples? Yes, they're in the fridge between the grapes and the oranges

Examples
My dad is in the kitchen.
The dog is on the sofa.
The toys aren't under the table.
